

Town of Lake Tomahawk held their regular Town Board Meeting on April 10, 2019 in the Raymond F. Sloan Community Center. All notices were posted according to the Open Meeting Law and the media was notified.

Present: Chairman George DeMet, Supervisor Larry Hoffman, Treasurer Michael Lynch and Town Clerk Sharon Trimberger Lintereur. Excused absence Supervisor Stephanie Sowatzka.

Chairman DeMet read the agenda of the Regular Town Board Meeting of April 10, 2019 and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Chairman DeMet led the people in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by DeMet and seconded by Hoffman to accept the minutes as written of March 13, 2019. All ayes, motion carried.

Approve the payment of bills and vouchers. Motion by Hoffman and seconded by DeMet to approve the ACH, EFT, EFTPS payments, checks 17840 to 17879 and payroll checks 4500 to 4511 for a total of \$46,390.88. Hoffman had questions on the issuing of two checks; Rudy's and Lakeland Senior Center. All Ayes, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: During the month of March, the town had income of \$24,226. The majority of which came from the state DOT for the quarterly highway aid of \$21,537. Expenses total \$67,552, of which the road department expenses were \$44,657 including \$18,543 in wages and benefits. Repairs on the grader were \$8,886. The annual payment of \$7,500 was also made for the Fourth of July Fireworks.

Lynch asked the town board to advertise for a new Town Treasurer and he will stay on to train a new treasurer. Cannot take any action on this request at this meeting, per the Town Chairman. Research whether the person would have to live in Lake Tomahawk.

County Representative: Bob Metropulos touched on vaping and suicides in the school districts. He would like to present a further presentation at a future board meeting.

Public Comment: Dave and Joyce Laszewski asked about the building addition, with DeMet answering their question as to where the present community building would be added on to. Laszewski also were concerned about the geese problem at the boat landing and if something could be done about it. DeMet said he would take this under advisement. Have had owl statues and other cut outs and they have all been stolen.

Request proposals for excavation and disposal of fill dirt at Choate Blvd. Trees down and extend parking area for the boat landing. Need to get rid of dirt, talk to Gregory's to see if they wanted it and advertise for proposals for excavation and the town crew could do cleanup. Motion made by Hoffman and seconded by DeMet to get proposals for excavation.

Culvert replacement and road reconstruction project: Sand Lake Road from Fawn Lake Road to town line. This is a half mile of road that needs repair. Motion made to advertise for bids by DeMet and seconded by Hoffman.

WTA Town Officials workshop on May 14, 2019. DeMet and Hoffman are going to this workshop.
