

Town of Lake Tomahawk held their regular Town Board Meeting on December 11, 2019 in the Raymond F. Sloan Community Center. All notices were posted according to the Open Meeting Law and the media was notified.

Present: Chairman George DeMet, Supervisors Larry Hoffman and Stephanie Sowatzka, Treasurer Cecilia Bianga and Town Clerk Sharon Trimmerger Lintereur.

Chairman DeMet called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. DeMet read the agenda of the Regular Town Board Meeting of December 11, 2019. DeMet led the people in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Larry Hoffman to approve the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of November 13, 2019 and Annual Budget Meeting of the Electors on November 13, 2019 as written by the Clerk. Seconded by Stephanie Sowatzka, all ayes, motion carried.

Approve the payment of bills and vouchers: Motion by DeMet and seconded by Sowatzka to approve the ACH, EFT, EFTPS payments, checks 18212 to 18250 and payroll checks 4683 to 4697 for a total of \$145,164.76, all ayes, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: During the month of November the Town had income of \$12,164.53, which included investment revenue of \$1,112.44. Parks revenue totaled \$200.00. Expenses totaled \$127,094.83 of which the Road Department expenses were \$58,648.57, including \$15,274.00 in wages and benefits. Payment to the building contractor was \$53,382.00 towards the new addition. DeMet made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded by Hoffman, all ayes, motion carried.

Designation of Poll Workers and Inspectors: The following people were asked to be approved as poll workers for 2020/2021 election years: Patricia Christy, Darlene Neumann, Rose Bean, Diane Hull, Constance Langren, Jeanne Godar, Catherine Parker, Christine Marquard, Karen Stodola, Virginia Davis, Nancy Schneider, Michelle Breheim and Nancy Mabry. Motion made by DeMet and seconded by Hoffman to approve the poll workers for the 2020/2021 election years, all ayes, motion carried.

Approve Temporary Class B Picnic License for Ice Jamboree/Ed Choinski: The Picnic license is for January 4, 2020 which would benefit the Lake Tomahawk Fire Department. Larry Hoffman made a motion to approve the Picnic License for the Ice Jamboree, Stephanie Sowatzka seconded the motion, all ayes, motion carried.

Request by Lake Tomahawk ATV Club to consider opening Lakewood Road and County D: after much discussion regarding the pros and cons of ATV's on paved roads, Catherine Parker asked about the liability issues and then asked that it go to the Plan Commission and let them handle the requests and issues that come with the requests. The requests are as follows: 1.) 2.6 miles on Lakewood Road from Cassian to Hwy. D. This 2.6 miles would connect Nokomis ATV Club to Lakeland ATV Club trails. 2.) 1.6 miles on Hwy. D from where the current trail ends to the Lake Tomahawk ATV Trail Head along the

railroad grade. This would connect current Hodag ATV Club Trails to Lake Tomahawk and would provide a "loop" for all riders to enjoy. Upon further discussion and questions asked regarding this request that could not be answered at the meeting, Stephanie Sowatzka made a motion to table the requests and have it go the Plan Commission, seconded by Larry Hoffmann, all ayes, motions carried.
