

Town of Lake Tomahawk held their regular Town Board Meeting on March 11, 2020 in the Raymond F. Sloan Community Center. All notices were posted according to the Open Meeting Law and the media was notified.

Present: Chairman George DeMet, Supervisors Stephanie Sowatzka and Larry Hoffman, Treasurer Cecilia Bianga and Town Clerk Sharon Trimmerger Lintereur.

Chairman DeMet called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. DeMet read the agenda of the Regular Town Board Meeting of March 11, 2020. DeMet led the people in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Hoffman and seconded by Sowatzka to approve the agenda of the March 11, 2020 Regular Town Board meeting, all ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Hoffman and seconded by Sowatzka to approve the minutes of the Regular Town Board Meeting on February 12, 2020 as written by the Clerk, all ayes, motion carried.

Approve the payment of bills and vouchers: Motion by Sowatzka and seconded by DeMet to approve the ACH, EFT and EFTPS payments, check 18355 to 18403 and payroll checks 4828 to 4748 for a total of \$714,726.70, all ayes, motion carried. DeMet also stated that a most of the monies went to the school districts.

Treasurer's Report: During the month of February the Town had income of -\$536,239.00 due to the pay out of taxes. Investment revenue was \$756.52. Expenses totaled \$62,677.00 of which Road Department expenses were \$29,560.00 including \$16,506.00 in wages and benefits. DeMet made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Hoffman, all ayes, motion carried.

County Representative: none present

Public Comment: none

Update on Assessor Contract: Sent emails to six (6) Assessors and two responded with a quote. Bowmar and Summit were the two firms that replied. Bowmar did a quote for one (1) year only and Summit did a three (3) year quote. Summit's would increase approximately \$260.00 per year for three (3) years and both were around \$14,000 per year. DeMet state that the Assessor, Edward O'Meara's, contract did not expire until after the Board of Review. DeMet would like to see if any other Assessors turn in a quote.

Broadband Tower/Northwoods Connect: DeMet received an email that Northwoods Connect is now accepting customers. The tower is located on Hwy. 47 South by the Bible Church.

Road Department Report: Weight restrictions, Elm Drive discontinuance, Fawn Lake Road bids: Weight limits will be going on in the Town of Lake Tomahawk on Friday, March 13, 2020 at noon. Elm Road Discontinuance has been revised and the Town Attorney, Greg Harrold, will be receiving a signed copy so that he can proceed with the discontinuance. The public hearing for Elm Road will be held on April 21, 2020 at 6:45 p.m., the evening of the Town of Lake Tomahawk's Annual Meeting. Fawn Lake Road bids:

this is approximately two (2) miles of road work on Fawn Lake Road and the intersection of Windpudding will also be done. The notice has been posted in the Lakeland Times. The deadline for the bids is April 30, 2020.

Future Agenda Items: Larry Hoffman wants to discuss the parking lots in town at the April meeting. He mentioned the drive-in parking lot and the Community Building. DeMet stated that the parking lot by the American Legion Post is going to be done by the Lake Tomahawk Road Department.

Correspondence: Larry Hoffman stated the Snow Fleas have signs that need to be posted at the Boat Landing, Keep off the Lake. Rick Bullock stated that the snowmobile signs were taken down showing where to go to get to the landing. DeMet stated that there is an email from Oneida County Planning and Zoning regarding recreational vehicles and detached garages used as a dwelling. The Clerk will give Board members a copy of this email.
