

The Town of Lake Tomahawk held a Special Board Meeting on May 22, 2018 in the Raymond F. Sloan Community Center. All notices were posted according to the Open Meeting Law and the media was notified.

Present: Chairman George DeMet, Supervisors Sowatzka and Hoffman and Clerk Sharon Trimmerger Lintereur. Chairman DeMet called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

A motion was made by Sowatzka to approve the agenda of May 22, 2018, seconded by Hoffman, all ayes.

Review and/or award bids on various road projects. Chairman DeMet opened the sealed bids from Pitlik and Wick, Musson Brothers and American Asphalt. After reviewing the bids for blacktopping of Big Doe Road, Dove Road, Woods Court, Northland Drive and Dorothy Lake Road the bids are as follows:

American Asphalt:

The Board reviewed the amounts for blacktopping. A motion was made by Sowatzka to approve the bid of American Asphalt and this was seconded by DeMet, all ayes.

Bids were reviewed from Pitlik and Wick and Fahrner for crack sealing and single chip sealing of Birch Road and West Bluebird Road. The bids were as follows:

Fahrner: \$50,033 combined

Pitlik and Wick

Birch Road	\$16,556.10 single chip seal
West Bluebird Road	\$28,429.37 single chip seal
Birch Road	\$ 2,959.60 crack seal
West Bluebird Road	\$ 2,672.70 crack seal

The Board reviewed the amounts for single chip seal and crack seal. A motion was by b DeMet to approve Pitlik and Wick, seconded by Sowatzka, all ayes.

After discussion regarding the proposed parking area adjacent to the Town Boat Landing, it was decided to get a different proposal with the town doing some of the work. DeMet made a motion to go ahead with excavation, seconded by Hoffman, all ayes.

Discussion regarding Asplundh Tree Service asking to be allowed to use herbicide treatments within power line right of ways. Lake Tomahawk has an ordinance banning spraying and was brought up whether to change the ordinance. A motion was made not to override the ordinance and not allow Asplundh to spray. Hoffman made a motion to not override ordinance, seconded by Sowatzka.

Motion made by DeMet and seconded by Sowatzka to adjourn at 6:28 p.m., all ayes.
